FIRE SAFETY CIRCULAR

To All Tenants

FIRES CAUSED BY UNATTENDED COOKING

Lately, there has been an increasing trend of kitchen fires caused by unattended cooking. We seek your cooperation in preventing such fires. A Service Charge will be issued to any tenant found negligent.

2. The general guidelines when observing kitchen fire safety includes:
 - i) **Do not leave pans unattended. Turn off the heat if you have to leave the kitchen;**
 - ii) Do not use matches or lighters to light gas cookers, please use spark devices which are safer;
 - iii) Take care if you are wearing loose clothing as this may easily catch fire;
 - iv) Keep the oven, hob and grill clean. Build-up of fat and grease may ignite easily;
 - v) Keep electrical leads, towels away from the cooker;
 - vi) Ensure that kitchen suppression system is serviced annually; and
 - vii) Do not use water to extinguish fires caused by cooking oil use the dry powder fire extinguisher instead.
