FIRE SAFETY CIRCULAR

To Airport Staff and Partners

OBSERVANCE OF FIRE SAFETY DURING FESTIVAL PRAYERS FOR THE SEVENTH MONTH OF THE LUNAR CALENDAR

As the Seventh Month Festival nears, we wish to take this opportunity to gently remind adherents that there shall be no indiscriminate and unattended burning of joss sticks, incense papers, oils, candles etc within Changi Airport, particularly **within buildings and at the airside**. The burning of these items is a potential ignition source and may cause fires.

2. You are therefore required to observe the following fire safety measures:
 - i) Burning is strictly prohibited within buildings and at the airside;
 - ii) Burning at the landside shall only be done from 31 July 2011 to 28 August 2011 at the **five** areas designated in Annex A;
 - iii) Burning of incense paper shall be carried out using a non-combustible container provided with a cover.
 - iv) Fire extinguishers shall be provided at the burning site.
