To All Airport Staff and Tenants

REMOVAL OF THE ADVANCE NOTIFICATION BY AIRLINES FOR THE CARRIAGE OF RADIOACTIVE MATERIALS AND AES FIRE VEHICLE ESCORT FOR TRANSPORTATION OF EXPLOSIVES REQUIREMENTS IN CHANGI AIRPORT

With immediate effect, AES will be removing the requirements for the advance notification by airlines for the carriage of radioactive materials and AES fire vehicle escort for transportation of explosives. The removal of these two requirements and concurrent withdrawal of their related form and circular (See Annex A) was done after extensive consultation with local and overseas counterparts on the best practices and also reference to existing guidance materials like the NFPA.

AES FIRE VEHICLE ESCORT FOR TRANSPORTATION OF EXPLOSIVES WITHIN SINGAPORE CHANGI AIRPORT

CIRCULAR HAS BEEN WITHDRAWN

In the interest of fire safety in Changi Airport, the Airport Emergency Service (AES) requires all transportation of explosives (Class D) within the airport to be escorted by an AES fire vehicle, except for Division 1.4 and all its compatibility groups regardless of their nett weight.

2 The fire vehicle escort service provided by AES is in accordance with the prevailing schedule of rates in the Fire Safety Manual.
