FIRE PREVENTION CIRCULAR

To All Ground Handling Agents and Airport Partners

Cessation of Airport Emergency Service (AES) Fireman Escort for External Vehicle Entering Airside

The requirements for AES fireman escort for external vehicles entering the airside was implemented in the 1980s. The purpose is to provide fire protection to vehicles which, then, operated mostly on carburettor engines and such vehicles poses high fire risk when operating in the airside.

2 Vehicles with carburettor engines are almost non-existent in Singapore as vehicles now operate on fuel injection engines which are low in fire risk when operating in the airside.

3 CAG have reviewed this requirement and following consultations with our stakeholders and the Land Transport Authority, the requirements for AES fireman escort for external vehicle entering the airside will cease immediately.
