




## Changi Airport Sensory Map

**Les Oiseaux** Level 1, Arrival


*Les Oiseaux*, meaning *The Birds*, is a delicately handcrafted stainless steel wire sculpture of three birds by French artist, Cédric Le Borgne. They reflect the nexus between sky and earth, and between dreams and reality.
