

ENVIRONMENT POLICY

Changi Airport Group is committed to pursuing environmentally sustainable growth. This policy outlines our approach towards minimising and managing the environmental impact of our operations at Changi Airport, including the following strategies:-

- **Protecting our environment:** we conduct our activities in an environmentally responsible manner, and prevent environmental pollution together with our airport community.
- **Conserving our resources:** we operate in a resource-scarce island nation and commit to responsible use of energy and water resources. We also aim to increase recycling and promote circular practices at the airport.
- **Reducing greenhouse gas emissions:** we target a 20% reduction in Scope 1 and 2 carbon emissions by 2030, against a FY18/19 baseline. To achieve this target, we will raise building energy efficiency and increase the share of renewables in our energy mix.
- **Adapting to climate change:** we will assess and manage material climate-related risks, ensuring our business is resilient against climate impacts.
- **Advancing green procurement:** we incorporate environmental considerations in our procurement decisions, thereby supporting the adoption of environmentally-responsible products and services.
- **Continual monitoring and improvement:** through data collection and analysis, we monitor our environmental performance and identify opportunities for continual improvement.
- **Complying** with all applicable legal and regulatory requirements relating to environmental aspects of our business activities.
- **Communication and collaboration:** through engagements with employees, airport partners and other stakeholders, we strive to raise awareness of environmental objectives and collectively build a Sustainable Changi.
